

LITERACY THEORY OF ACCELERATION

STATEMENT(S)

- 6 out of 25 (24%) literacy resources are recognized by 50% of families surveyed with 0-5 yr olds.
- 7 out of 25 (28%) literacy resources have been used in the past six-months by 10% or more of families surveyed with 0-5 yr olds

GOAL

Improve the collaboration and coordination of existing community literacy resources in alignment with the K-3 literacy plan of the Flagstaff Unified School District.
